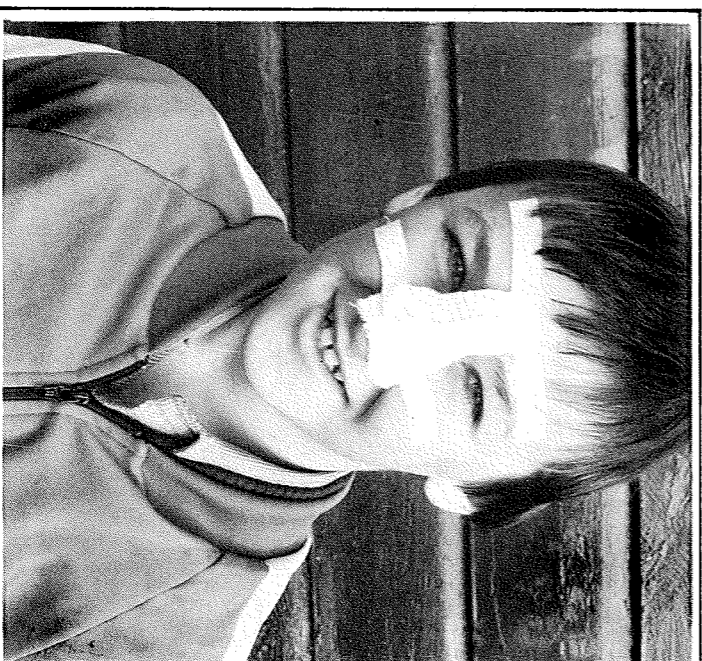
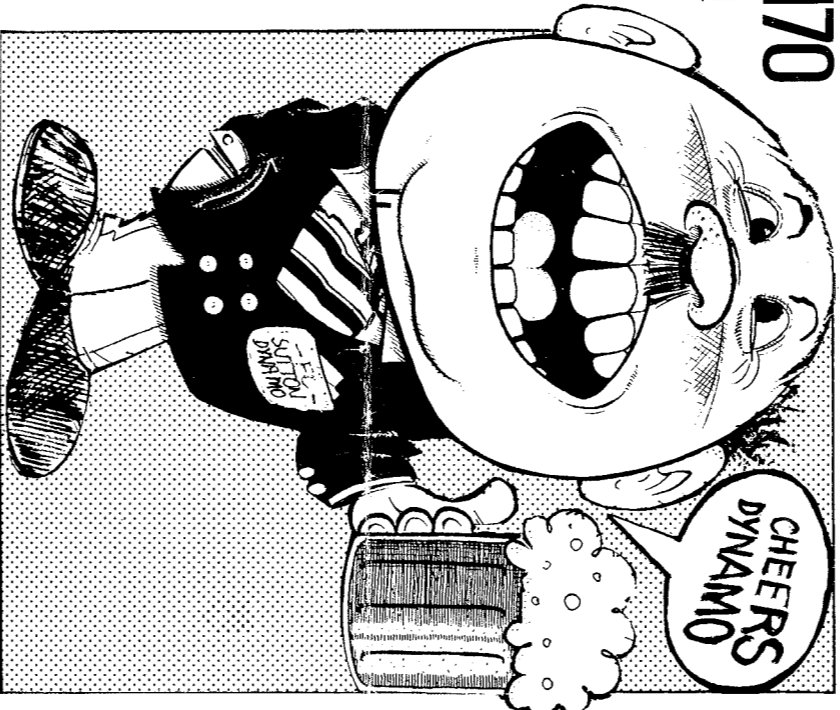
After our recent abysmal performance against Flectdown it was exhilarating to watch the boys' performance against the Crayford Arrows.
